



REVIEW: AIR DRAWING WITH 3DOODLER START PEN SET

The <u>3Doodler Start</u> is a child-safe pen that you can use to create fun plastic sculptures. Little kids and adults will find it a perfect introduction to 3D art and accessory-making. The pen has a nozzle where melted thin plastic ink come out, but that doesn't get too hot, which makes it a safe 3D art printing toy for kids.

The kit consists of a plump pen with packets of plastic filament, as well as silicone molds to start your 3D art projects. To use it, just feed the colored plastic tube of your choice from a port at the back of the pen to melt into ink. Initially, you can use the mold to create designs that you can stick together to create sided structures. It goes with a booklet to help you in making basic figures.

It's easy to use. Read the instructions, and start working on your designs immediately. Make anything from simple keychains to intricate dioramas.

This toy encourages a lot of creativity because your kid can veer away from using the molds and create their 3D designs, once they get used to it. Also, with its BPAfree plastics and no-heat nozzle, it is safe for use by everyone. That said, always

follow the age indication of the toy. While it is safe for young kids aged eight years and above, you may have to wait a little if you want to purchase one for your toddler.

The 3Doodler Start comes with a micro USB charger, so you don't need to buy batteries every single time and no cords to complicate the process. However, make

> sure to have your charger ready at all times because this toy can be quite addicting and the possibilities for creation are endless.

The 3Doodler Start is a real improvement from the other pens before it because the plastic tubes melt quickly, but harden slowly. This feature is a good advantage because you can easily correct mistakes in your design

without wasting precious eco-plastic ink.

Two notable things to remember when buying the 3Doodler Start for your kids or yourself, do purchase a lot of plastic filaments so you won't run out in the middle of an art attack. Buy enough colored tubes to help you practice. Also, another tip is to prepare all of your plastic filaments and silicon molds before working, so you won't lose precious ink in the process.

REVIEW: CREATIVE GALAXY ARTY'S TOOL BELT

Creative Galaxy is a popular art show that many kids love to watch and if you are looking for fun artsy activities for your children to do, then the Creative Galaxy Arty's Tool Belt comes highly-recommended. This kit comes with a tool belt where you can put all of your crayons and brushes while doing your activities.

It also includes a doodle pad, coloring booklet, stickers, the brushes that you will need, and pads that let you paint with water. You can keep all of them in a nice, adjustable, yellow tool belt.

"Interactive" art will surely blow your kid's mind away. Kids totally love the paint with water pads wherein you can paint colored pictures of arty and the galaxy characters with water to reveal their true colors. There are two pads, which helps if to prevent the kids from fighting over the coloring books.

The pictures are actually dots of two different colors



that combine to create a new color when painted with water. The takeaway is that painting with water is less messy than the

usual means of painting. Great for the kids as well as for the parents!

Kids can also create greeting cards to express themselves using the doodle pads and the construction paper as well. Your children can pretty much do whatever they want with the art supplies.

The <u>Creative Galaxy Arty's Tool Belt</u> is also toddler-friendly. Improve your kid's creativity and fine motor skills. You can paint with your hands, tear, cut (always with supervision), draw, etc. On the flip side, bigger kids can create short picture stories using stickers of various characters.

Creating art is an excellent quiet activity. It helps to improve your children's focus, and the <u>Creative Galaxy Arty's Tool Belt</u> offers great value for the amount of art that your kids can do with it. REVIEW: ETCH A SKETCH FREESTYLE TOY

This toy bears the name a classic toy, but the resemblance ends there. If you grew up playing with Etch A Sketch, you might have labored for hours turning the knobs to make a drawing, shaking the toy a couple of times when you are not happy with the progress.

This version has transformed and updated the iconic toy for the modern world with a bit of improvement. It's easier to draw with the Etch A Sketch Freestyle Toy. Drawing on the classic Etch A Sketch takes a focused skill. Successfully completing a drawing will take a couple of shakes and starting over again from the beginning when you are not happy with your progress. You either made the lines to short or too long, made a knob-related mistake, or had difficulty using the two knobs together to create what you wanted, which is very frustrating.

This twist allows you to draw with little effort and skill. You use a pen or stylus to draw on it instead of two knobs. The colored lines come out with little effort and they are crisp. It also includes two stamps that allow you to make clouds, circle, crown, and stars on the screen.

The screen is black, and the background colors are fixed. Once you draw on it, the pen and the stamp reveals the pattern. Your drawings come out in the cute colors of the rainbow. Erasing your drawing on the



screen is effortless as well, similar to shaking the classic toy. When you are tired of the image, just turn the toy upside down and give the toy a vigorous up and down shake.

The pen is attached to the toy, but the stamps are not. They snap

back in, and they won't really fall out easily unless you drop the toy. Although they fit securely into the open spots in the toy, you need to take precautions to avoid from losing them. They are also double-sided, so it may take a bit of getting used to. The image on the top is not the image that will show up on the screen.

This is perfect for kids who love to write and draw on things non-stop. A limitless sketching pad will keep them entertained for hours.

The toy itself not very thick and is relatively lightweight. It's a good on-the-go toy that you can bring for car trips, doctor's appointment, or salon appointment. This toy requires a battery, so make sure you have a supply of AG13 replacements. The batteries are screwed to the body of the toy. This prevents accidents since small batteries are choking hazards.

REVIEW: FURREAL ROARIN' TYLER, THE PLAYFUL TIGER

Tiger-fans look out! Here comes Tyler! He's an interactive tiger that children will enjoy having as a pet. He is very lifelike, like a real cat, he moves his tail, mouth, head, ears, and eyes. He poses playfully and leans down. You will often forget that he is mechanical.

He roars! But that is not even the best part about Tyler. He doesn't just roar; this pet roars back when you roar at him. He reacts when you pet him, and he will respond to the sound of your voice, like a real cat who wants to play. He has a duck toy, and he will make a sound if you put it in his mouth.

He is life-like. He is as large a house cat, and he moves. His beautiful, fluttering blue eyes and his





cooing will certainly convince imaginative children that he is real. It will be hard to get over the fact that he is a toy and not a live animal. Young kids may be a bit intimidated with him at first, especially very young children, but they will quickly get over their fears and be intrigued with his cuteness.

He is friendly. In children's mind, <u>Tyler</u> is a breathing and leaving toy that responds to their play, pets, and laugher. The sound of the levers and gears can be heard, but they are hardly noticeable to children with very active imaginations. They will soon forget that he is an animatronic animal. His movements look so authentic and smooth; you will stop thinking of him as

a toy. The inside of his mouth is also very detailed, and his nose has very fine details.



He is very sweet, and his personality, movements, and sounds are very child-friendly. He is always just loving and playful. He never becomes aggressive or intimidating to scare kids. It's like watching a child play with a real cat, without the danger of getting scratched or bitten.

He responds. All of Tyler's movements move in unison, giving the illusion that he is really responding to his playmate. All the little movements of this body, ears, tail, front legs, jaw, eyeballs, and eyelids will ignite

children's imagination. He responds to sound and petting in many areas of his body, including his head and nose. But if you really want him to move, then all you need to do is push the button under the fur on his back.

You can take him anywhere. Tyler is heavy enough that it feels like you are carrying a real animal when you pick him up. He is also very soft. This tiger's fur is high-quality and great to the touch. He has no sharp objects and children do not need to avoid certain areas of his body. His very study and he will last for a long time.

He does not make too much noise when no one is playing with him. But he does pick up sounds and will respond to any noise, so it might not be wise to let the children sleep with him. He also has the tendency to roar and purr, wanting to play when he senses someone is nearby. You can turn him off if needed. Just find the switch under the fur on his belly to prevent him from waking up anyone in the middle of the night.

When no one is around to play with <u>Tyler</u>, he will go into sleep mode. And once he sleeps, the only way to wake him up is the button on his back. He cost a bit more than other toys of his kind, but he is indeed more interactive.

REVIEW: GREEN TOYS FERRY BOAT WITH MINI CARS BATHTUB TOY

Looking for a carrier boat with extra vehicles inside and floats in water? The Green Toys Ferry Boat is an excellent choice if you're looking for a fun and durable bath toy to last your child for years. They detach and dry easily, too, so no need to worry about molds and dirt from growing inside your kid's toys. The set comes with a big ferry boat and two small cars that fit inside the carrier boat and is available in blue and white or green and white color.

This toy set is also BPA-free, and only high-quality recycled plastic materials were used to create it. This feature is important to note because we want to make sure we don't contribute to pollution and that we teach children the value of taking care of the environment.

this set, with difficulty levels ranging from easy, medium, to advanced.

The machines do various tasks, such as drop, lift, roll, pivot, swing, and spin. Each of them is awesome on their own, but when you assemble them together, you can create a chain reaction that will educate and fascinate you and your kids. You can experiment and rearrange the machines depending on the task that you want them to perform. All you need is a bit of imagination and patience.

This cleverly thought of educational kit includes a wellillustrated and detailed booklet on how to assemble each machine, guiding you on how to fold the paper components and more.

ARTICLE: HISTORY OF CHRISTMAS



Commercial activities during
Christmas today are often
decried as making the season
too materialistic. This has
caused comments that the
religious aspect of Christmas
is so overlooked and
overshadowed that its
celebration seems to be
purely pagan. But today's
comparisons aren't the first
there has been some link
between Christmas and

pagan celebrations. As a religious, church leaders instituted Christmas during winter because that time of year was a popular for the celebrations of many pagan festivals. The hope was that Christmas would also become a holiday that would gain much popularity.

Long before the birth of Jesus Christ, people in various parts of Europe would celebrate light and birth in the darkest days of winter. The winter solstice, when the harshest part of winter was over, was a time of celebration for many peoples because they would look forward to more hours of sunlight during the longer days ahead.

The Norse in Scandinavia celebrated Yule from the winter solstice on December 21 through to January. Men brought home logs that were lighted and a feast

would take place until the log was completely burned. Each spark from the fire was believed to represent a new pig or calf to be born in the coming new year.



The pagan god Odin was honored by Germans during the mid-winter holiday. Odin inspired great fear in the Germans who believed that Odin traveled at nights through the sky to observe people and make a decision about who would perish or prosper in life. This belief caused most people to stay inside during the period.

In Rome it was the god of agriculture, Saturn, who was honored in a holiday called Saturnalia. It was a holiday that started during the week that led up to the winter solstice and continued for a month with hedonistic celebrations. There was plenty of food and drink and the normal social class rules of who had privilege and power in Roman society were totally disregarded as everyone participated in the festivities. Some Romans

also had a feast called Juvenalia to honor children and the birthday of the sun god Mithra was sometimes celebrated by the upper classes.



In the early years of the start of Christianity the main holiday was
Easter. It was in the 4th
Century that church officials made a decision to have the birth of

Jesus celebrated as a holiday and Pope Julius I chose December 25 as the day of Jesus' birth. The holiday, which was first called the Feast of the Nativity, spread to England by the end of the 6th Century and to Scandinavia by the end of the 8th Century.

Church leaders achieved the goal of having Christmas celebrations, including attendance at church, become popular during the winter solstice, but they were unable to control other pagan-like celebrations during Christmas. Believers would attend church on Christmas and then participate later in raucous and drunken celebrations. But by the Middle Ages, from around the 5th to the 16th Century, Christianity had outgrown paganism as a religion.

The celebration of Christmas in Europe changed in the early 17th Century when Oliver Cromwell and the Puritans gained power in England in 1645. To remove

decadent behavior from the society, Cromwell cancelled Christmas as the Puritans noted that the Bible doesn't mention any date for Jesus' birth. The lack of this information and specific Biblical references to Christmas is also cited by religious groups like Jehovah Witnesses as the reason they don't observe or participate in Christmas. Christmas celebrations returned in England around 1649 when Charles II was restored to the throne.

Christmas wasn't a holiday in early America because the Pilgrims who came to America had even stricter beliefs than Cromwell and the Puritans. Christmas celebrations were even forbidden in Boston from 1659 to 1681. During the same time however, settlers in Jamestown in Virginia were reported to have enjoyed Christmas.



After the American Revolution Christmas again lost popularity and it wasn't until June 26, 1870 that Christmas was declared a federal holiday. Christmas in the United States gained popularity as a holiday period during the 19th Century.

Christmas celebrations also changed at that time to be more family-centered rather than being carnival-like.

REVIEW: LASER PEGS T-REX 20-IN-1 LIGHTING UP YOUR KID'S IMAGINATION

<u>Laser Pegs T-Rex</u> is very much like how you would assemble Legos. However, they are a little different because LED lights illuminate them in the dark, which

adds to their appeal. Also, each set can make 20 different animals. They are also compatible with other Laser Pegs sets and building block brands, so you can build unlimited designs using a combination of the pieces.

Each box comes with an instruction manual with number groupings that you can refer to when you start building. Also included are the pieces of the figure, light up power bricks, sound blocks, and pegs with 15 LED light. This toy runs on batteries, so you

might want to buy extra ones when you decide to get the toy, but don't worry because the kit got you covered the first time.

This toy works just like other building, and construction toys do. When connecting them, make sure to avoid forcing parts together to avoid damage and bad design. You may have to search for the instructions on how to create the other animals. You'll also find many people who are sharing their designs and patterns over the

> internet since the pieces are highlycustomizable. Moreover, after doing the T-Rex, your kid will more or less have an idea how to build the others based on intuition.

One practical tip to remember is to provide for a container for loose parts since there will surely be plenty left so that you can cover all of the dinosaurs. Doing this will also help you prevent losing them and eventually ending up with an incomplete animal.

Some designs may take more time to assemble, but this is the beauty

Each robot has a vast set of capabilities. The cat can only stand and sit, so don't expect it to run. On the other hand, Vernie, the standing robot, can talk, turn, respond to handshake, even fart. You can plan Vernie's course using the app and let it lose around the house.

If the app crashes, powering your iPad or tablet will resolve the problem. Also, make sure to have your gadgets fully charged before starting on a robot project. You don't want the gadget to run out of juice halfway through the building.

Since you can build 5 different robots from the set, get ready to open all 11 bags at once. Each robot will need pieces from all the bags. It's best to put the pieces in sturdy containers, and you need to be careful not to mix the pieces up with your existing Lego pieces. Also, make sure not to misplace a piece. If ever, you can probably find a replacement among your

previously owned Lego.

You will need 6 AAA batteries for the move hub. The robots will drain regular batteries rather quickly, so buying rechargeable ones is cost-effective. Moreover, the first thing the app does after you start it up is to establish a connection with the move hub. You won't be able to get any further until it does, so ready your batteries before you start building.

ARTICLE: CARE AND DISPOSAL OF CHRISTMAS TREES



Since so much time and effort is put into selecting the perfect Christmas tree, it follows that similar consideration should also be given to giving the tree the best possible care. Otherwise, there will be disappointment if needles start to brown or turn yellow, or branches begin to break with days or weeks to go before the season is over. Safety is also an important reason to take proper care of your Christmas tree because a drying Christmas tree also presents a grave danger as a fire hazard. The average Christmas tree should last for about five to six weeks if the proper care is given to it.

After selecting a Christmas tree and getting it home, the first thing that should be done is to make a fresh cut and place it into a stand with water. A Christmas tree shouldn't be mounted dry and the water in its stand should be replenished regularly. A fresh cut is made by cutting about an inch off the bottom in a slight diagonal shape to help the absorption of water. If a fresh cut isn't going to be made immediately after getting the tree home, it should be placed in a container with water and left to stand in a shaded area that is away from the wind.



If a fresh cut isn't made and the Christmas tree is left exposed to air, the vessels for transporting water can become blocked. If this happens, another fresh cut can correct the problem and the tree would need to be immediately put in a container with water.

Your Christmas tree should be secure in its stand and it should be placed away from open flames or sources of heat such as furnaces, fireplaces and air vents, all of which may dry it out. Decoration of the tree should also begin after it has been mounted in its stand. Several

decoration precautions should be taken to lessen or avoid the Christmas tree being a fire hazard.



Ornaments that have an open flame or candles should never be used for decoration. Christmas tree lights should be checked to make sure the bulbs are working properly, the connections are intact and that no part of the cord is damaged. If there appears to be any exposed wiring or bulbs that are not working or which are working intermittently, that string of Christmas tree lights shouldn't be used.

A good Christmas tree stand should be selected since water is the most important item to getting the longest life out of your Christmas tree. In selecting a stand, find out the amount of water it can hold when a tree is placed in it. Some water will be displaced from the

space taken up by the base of the tree so it is important that a selection is not made based on the total volume of water the stand can hold.

According to the National Christmas Tree Association, the average Christmas tree may absorb up to one gallon of water each day. It is therefore important to check the water everyday and replenish it accordingly. To make sure your Christmas tree gets enough water, the Association recommends that one quart of water is required for each inch of the diameter of the tree's trunk.

After Christmas is over and your wonderfully decorated Christmas tree has provided much joy, it is important to remove it before it dries out. Options to discard your Christmas will likely depend on the services offered by your municipality. Some municipalities will pick up Christmas trees on particular days, with a cut-off date. Some towns may require that residents take their trees to specific locations, while in others Christmas trees will be picked up with the garbage, again up to a certain date. But Christmas trees should never be burned in the fireplace as it can cause the build up of creosote, a colorless, oily substance.

There's also the choice that you can continue to get a different use from your Christmas tree by cutting it to pieces yourself and be environmentally sensitive by using it for mulch.

The <u>Lionel Mega Tracks</u> are customizable railways that allow cars to race and perform stunts like the corkscrew curve, loops, and the hairpin turns. This set comes with a 20-ft track that you can assemble as you

wish, and a car that is a cross between a train and a race car. Clamp the vehicle and watch it perform gravity-defying stunts. It comes with an instructional manual, and although it takes time to put together, it is satisfying to run the car on the track.

To set up the track, look for a flat, broad base like the floor to accommodate the entire thing.

Then, group the different beam

sizes and find a way to clamp down the areas or structures that touch the base to prevent the track from moving flimsily while the car is running. Also, assign a container for each type of small parts like couplings, joints, and the different kinds of track supports. Ideally, you should set it up for your kids to enjoy.

A useful reminder when buying the <u>Lionel Mega Tracks</u> is that the controller requires a 9V battery. Buy an extra just in case. Charge the vehicle while you're setting up the tracks. You will find the switch on the left side of the car, plug the jack and make sure the LED light is on to indicate that it's charging.

You can record your runs by setting up the phone holder so that you can take videos of your car running around the track. You can modify the route to your liking if you feel like one part dips too much that the car

hits the table or the floor every time. Not all joints will have support to take advantage of the car's momentum. However, too much speed can cause your vehicle to derail sometimes, which is why it is essential to know the right speed for the vehicle to travel without falling.

of touching them together, and your kids can enjoy the amazing things that circuits can do.



It comes with Ryder figure, who is the main character in the show, his ATV, a baby octopus that kids can save repeatedly, lifesavers and a launcher, an anchor, rescue carrier, a ladder, a crane, vehicles, and more. Your little one can play with this sea vehicle in many ways as a sea vehicle. Launch those

orange lifebuoys to the direction of someone they're pretending to save. Attach the anchor to the side and the back and lower it if your child wants to park it.

And that's not the most awesome part yet; the sea patroller converts into a land vehicle in just one motion. Push the cockpit forward, and the wheels of the truck will launch. The sounds are even different when it's a sea or a land vehicle. Use three button cell batteries

and make sure to lock the battery cover to prevent small kids from accidentally swallowing them.

The Paw Patrol Sea Patroller is a truly unique toy.

Inside, your child can find a crane that can lift Ryder up and down on a carrier. Two vehicles can also come in and out of the boat or the truck through a hatch on its rear. Despite it being ½ truck and ½ boat, remind your child not to play with it in water because it will not float, owing to the hatch that opens and closes at the rear and the weight of the extra vehicles it carries within its body.

Kids often love to reenact Paw Patrol scenes when they play, and it helps build their creativity and imagination. If you're planning to

buy this <u>Paw Patrol Sea Patroller Transforming Vehicle</u> with <u>Lights and Sounds</u>, a great companion to this toy that you might want to buy separately are the six rescue dog figures that also star in the show, along with their respective vehicles. The manufacturer of this robots also made an effort to recorded Owen Wilson's voice, McQueen's voice actor in the movie, for all the toy's voice sound, which is nothing less than awesome. It's like the racecar itself magically jump off the screen and into your house. And with the help of the toy's app, you can adjust the volume of the sound coming out from the good-quality on vehicle speaker.

McQueen's eyes are clear and bright, adjusting well depending on what the car is doing, as well as its speed and direction where it's heading. Just like the car in the cartoons! The charging port is placed at the car's gas cap, which gives it a real race car look. The car has touch panels on its body, and it will respond when touched. Children will certainly be captivated by it, even the ones who have no idea who Lightning McQueen is.

It's not an RC car, and it runs differently than an RC car. You won't be able to drive it with an RC control and don't drive it at RC speeds as well. The control interface is quite different. It will take some time to get the hang of the controls, especially if you have driven RC cars in the past, pistol grip or traditional. You control it through your phone. Once you've installed the app, you will be able to run and control it in no time. REVIEW: STEP2 MCLAREN RIDE-ON SPORTS CAR

Ride-on toys like the <u>Step 2 McLaren 570S</u> are popular among toddlers as they are perfect for sensorial skills development. This toy comes with a bar handle that you can hold and push while strolling with your little one. The design is very much like the real deal with high-quality materials and easy-to-follow instructions.

Be prepared to assemble it using tools like a hammer,

screwdriver, pliers, wrench, and a ratchet set. It is important to prepare all of the materials first and go over the instructions several times before building it, so you'll be able to set it up correctly.

The wheels and axels are a little tricky to put together, but you will certainly manage. Make sure to align the wheels properly before putting the hubcap in place, since it can be difficult to remove if you want to fix the assembly. Building the toy will take at least thirty minutes for an inexperienced

person to complete. Once the car is complete, you can already use it to push your tot around.

The <u>Step2 McLaren</u> comes with a bottle holder for the little one and a cup holder for the parent. It rides

smoothly on grass and any other terrain, so no need to worry about getting stuck and a bumpy ride for the tot.

The cockpit has ample room and a secret compartment under the seat for the little one's things to hide. The ride-on toy comes in a bright orange color and a nice realistic revving sound to make it easy for motorists to see. It requires two triple-A batteries if you plan to use this honk feature, but kids love it even without the sound. It also has a sturdy seatbelt snap

for an added safety.

Storing the sports car is also easy. The detachable handle lets you keep it in a small area. It is also possible to bring it to keep your kids occupied while on vacation and taking a stroll. You might want to bring a big car if you're planning to take it because it may not fit in a small car compartment.

If you're looking for a push car to keep your toddler occupied during trips or your strolls around the neighborhood, then consider getting

The kit comes with a Tomy Bath Foam unit, with suction caps that allows you to attach it to the wall of your bathroom. You then place a foaming bath formula in the cup, and it's ready to use.

The best advantage from this is that bath time is fun and the children are much easier to coax into the shower because foam and bubbles are always a hit. Also, it doesn't require charging or replacing batteries. Just good old water fun. This foam factory stays on the wall firmly, and it operates smoothly. There is a cone holder on the left and a lever on the right that the child pulls to create soft foam.

Young children can also use it outside for a refreshing water play when the heat picks up. The instructions suggest putting the right amount of bubble bath ½ cup to three cups water. This ratio is good to last an entire 30-minute bath. Personally, I even add more water to extend the play time, and it works just as fine.

The Tomy foam factory is a great bath time toy for the kids, just remind the tiny ones not to eat the soap cones when no one's looking. The <u>Tomy Bath Foam Cone Factory</u> is a perfect gift idea for kids who are at least 18 months old. It encourages fine motor skills, independence, and imaginative play.



You can attach it on bathroom tiles, tubs, or any clean, flat surface. Wipe the surface of the wall dry, but wet the surface of the suction caps a little for an added pull so that the toy stays in place. Remember not to set it too high such that a toddler may have to strain to pull down the lever. Adjust the height of the toy when necessary. The closer it is to the children in the tub, the better.

Consider your bathroom walls and your child's balancing ability when purchasing the product. Rough surfaces will not be able to hold the foam cone factory. Other than that, just purchase, attach to a wall where it's safe and convenient, pour the bubble soap mixture and let your little ones enjoy their bath.

Aside from the pony, the box comes with a carrot, apple, comb, and a sugar cube. These items each elicit a specific response from the pony. Kids who play with Zoomer somewhat require a learning curve to make her perform all of the pre-programmed actions and tricks. First, you'll need to ensure that you have 4 rechargeable AA batteries available to make it work. Turn on the button on her underbelly.

Moving the apple near her mouth satisfies her hunger as indicated by her eyes. She'll let you know when she's full. Using the carrot, in the same way, starts training, and using the sugar cube rewards the pony.

Zoomer, the Show Pony, can also show signs of tiredness. When she falls asleep quickly, it means that the batteries need replacing or recharging. Don't forget to purchase new batteries if you are interested in buying this toy. Also, when your kid is done playing the pony, don't forget to turn off the switch in her underbelly to ensure that the batteries do not get drained.

They take turns being blindfolded spun around a couple times to disorient them a little then told to walk to the reindeer and place the nose on the picture. The child who places the nose closes to the reindeer's nose wins.
